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# Introduction:

There are many questions like this. Think about it.

Anybody in this world can say:

I am a born doctor.

I am a born scientist.

Did any doctors ever say, "I am a doctor because I was born in a doctor's family"?

Did any scientist ever say, "I am a scientist because my parents were scientists"?

No...this sounds illogical. And stupid... People will laugh at this kind of person.

But now think about this:

When someone says I am Muslim or Christian or Jewish or Hindu, everybody will accept it. In the same way, to become a real human or a real follower of any religion, what you are following or practicing now, ask yourself this question, which is, I think, enough to make you think about the reality of your own life, your own belief, or your own existence on this earth.

# Molding Begins

I USED THIS word “molding” specifically to signify how your life changes after you start developing your mind and your body with your surroundings and the people and the circumstances you are living within. Each event and uncertainty molds your life in different ways.

We become the same human being our surroundings want us to be, what our leaders want us to be, what our teachers want us to be, what our parents want us to be. A few things in us are different from others; they are in us, in our soul, a gift of nature. What cannot be changed are the traits of our personality.

Read carefully wherever I mention nature. Till now I have not mentioned anything that makes you think I am talking about God, that God made this and that. Then I would sound more like the translators of scriptures or a preacher in some church.

We start thinking...and thinking can be done in two ways: the way which has been shown to us and the way which we found by ourselves.

Here we think the same way our whole life, which is being taught to us by whom? By the people who influence us, by the preachers or teachers of our so-called religions, and the nearby events that make up our mind and teach us, give us direction to think in that way. We soon stop using our own mind and follow them, asking no questions and accepting that what they say is true as they are more knowledgeable

than we are.

We start thinking, acting, talking, and behaving in the same way as others in our reach or doing what they want us to do. We have not been asked to choose one of the different types of religion, but we have been asked to follow without following what we are interested in and what we understand. We follow those in society. We keep on following unknowingly and we start practicing all that others do in our family.

We get teachings from elders in our family and from religious teachers how to perform rituals and we do so, not knowing if everything they say is true or false.

And in due course when we become adults, despite having the power of a thinking mind and intellectual potential, we don't have time to study these realities or myths, to verify how true or how false they are. What we follow in childhood we keep on following throughout our life. We are already programmed by religious personalities or teachers or preachers, thinking that it's beyond our power or capacity to think like them or talk like them or be a scholar like them.

LET ME ASK A FEW MORE QUESTIONS:

- 1) What makes that scholar a scholar in your eyes?
- 2) What makes him so popular that you accept whatever he says?
- 3) What makes him so pure that we feel he is God's loved one?
- 4) What makes him so prominent that we think we cannot be like him?

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Again the answer is in your mind. And you know it well.

Then again my questions to all human beings:

- 1) Why can't we be like them?
- 2) What did they get from nature that we didn't?
- 3) What can they do that we cannot?
- 4) Are they not human like us?
- 5) Don't we all possess the same qualities and features?

The answer is in your mind and you know it. JUST THINK...

- 1) Then why is the molding of our life in their hands?
- 2) Why can't we make our own choices about practices and rituals?
- 3) Why can't we study the truth or the falsities about what we follow?
- 4) Why can we become humans and then have to become Christians, Jews, Muslims, and Hindus without having knowledge of our own religion?

After trying to search for truth, the right thing we find is what our way of life is, and that's the truth we have been seeking for decades. We will discuss this in detail and open more closed doors in your mind. You may think with your own mind, and you will get answers.

As of now, this chapter is not yet so clear. I am sure the answer lies within you. Do not let others mold your life without your permission because everything in this world can be stolen from you, but your mind and your heart are your

own. You own them and no one else can steal them from you. Your intellect is your own, and no one else can hamper it. You should use it in the right way so that you can think wisely, discover the truth, find satisfaction, and get all the answers to your questions.

The common example involves the living things and the nonliving things on this earth which have some sort of influence molding them, their personality, their existence, and their shape.

We humans have superpower minds; we have the freedom to accept anything or reject anything. The same thing is applicable to your life, whether to accept what you are or what you want to be. But getting the truth by finding the truth and not from accepting what others says. And not what others follow.

Molding is on others till the age where you are not in a state of thinking or reasoning for the things happening in your life. In the adult stage you may go for truth or in search of Truth, through gaining knowledge of the things that raise questions in your mind.

All the natural phenomena and the collective information, which is easily accessible, may lead you toward truth, but you should reason. Ask yourself questions, and if you get the right answers, I am sure you will be satisfied with what you are following or doing.

We are not nonliving things that can be molded the way the pot of clay can be molded on the wheel; and we don't just remain passive, doing nothing, rather following others without questions and not trying to find peace of mind. We get

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relaxed, so we are happy, no need to think further. Remember, man learns from his mistakes and he keeps on learning till the end of his life.

In struggling to live this life and to earn a living, we forget to ask why we are on this earth.

Why are we on this earth?

How should we be on this earth?

The answer you will find within you.

# Development of Mind and Body

OUR MIND AND body play important roles in shaping our personality. The mind is the ultimate source of power and guidance, gifted by nature to all living beings. Human minds are more powerful than those of any other living creature in this world. We definitely don't need any proof to prove this.

Human minds are capable of storing and retrieving the information stored in it at lightning speed, and that's how what we do differs from other living beings, right from the beginning of our lives till the end.

The human mind is a great creation of nature and designed in such a complex way that we need no proof to prove it's a supreme creation and needs no comparison with any other creation on this earth.

The development of mind starts in our childhood till we become mature enough to understand, think, take action, and make conclusions on our own. The process takes time, and this process is called development or evolution. Everything, whether living or nonliving, takes time to come to its final stage or finished state, its complete, developed state.

There is beautiful word I found while studying different languages of the world. "Rubuyat" in Arabic means a process from its beginning stage till it's finished. That makes me think that every single nonliving and living being in this world goes

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through this process, so why not our belief or religion? I found the answer is that they do.

There is an important point in our belief and religion where these processes go through other's influence and injectors in our life and not with our own wish. Hence our mind does not think about it nor do we try to find out if what we are following is true or false. If taken with intellect, this process can go in a different way if we want.

Let's say when we are children our parents teach us about all religion, give us education about all the religions in this world, and give us a choice of what we want to follow. You can study and use your own intellect and choose to become a Christian, Muslim, Hindu, Jew, or any other. I don't think that has happened since human history developed.

No one ever thinks about it willingly or not. We have been forced emotionally, dramatically, and blindly to follow what has been followed by our forefathers. And we don't even know when we were brought into it. Some of us raise our interest and try to find out truth and study. I am sure we have the right path on which our creator has asked us to walk, and I am sure we have the real meaning of life and the real so-called God.

It's very important to understand these developments of our mind and our body and how we are using them in terms of anything and everything.

We see many preachers, debaters, religious leaders, and priests; we should listen to them but also study on our own what they are talking about. I have heard many of them talking about scriptures, and they say everything that has



been written in scriptures without giving any reference of chapters or verses, and I ask them where it's written. I have been told many times, "Who cares where it's written? Who wants to know about that?" If people believe that it's in scriptures, let them believe it. Here I was amazed and I thought, *I don't want to follow what they themselves don't know they are advising.*

#### BIG QUESTION AGAIN: WHAT SHOULD WE FOLLOW?

The answer we have to find out ourselves in the same way we have to find our own way of life. I want to make clear that we don't need big philosophical minds; we don't have to be scholars to understand the scriptures. We can become more scholarly than so-called religious scholars if we study, if we get knowledge. The power of knowledge is the door of advancement, the right path, and the door toward truth.

We all should use our minds. Our intellect has been given in the same proportion to every human being, but it all depends on how we use it and how we develop it, through research, study, and investigation. Use your intellect with an open mind and heart and get the truth.

I would like to point out a very important factor in the advancement of every single human being, something that stops people from progressing their own knowledge in terms of religion: LANGUAGE.

We all grew up in different states, different communities, and different countries. We are different races, castes, creeds, and religion; we speak different languages. And our religious scriptures are in different languages; most of the time we don't understand. of the Quran, the Bible, Bhagavad Gita,

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Yajurveda, and Chandogya Upanishad are in different languages like Arabic, Hebrew, and Sanskrit.

We may not understand it, but still we keep on reading the scriptures without understanding the language, as it's not our language. Those scriptures came with those messengers in those countries where the people speak those languages. The language barrier is the biggest barrier in human development in terms of the religion we are following.

We read it, recite it again and again, knowing not a single meaning from it, and we think we get virtues for that. Reciting something which is not understood...how can that give you virtue? Common sense. If someone speaks English and not French and I give him a French song to recite every single day so that he will get virtue from it, and the person does, what do you call him? An intelligent man? A man with a mind?

Why are scriptures like that? Why don't we take this seriously? When you are reading someone's translation, it is that person's understanding of the Arabic, English, Sanskrit, and Hebrew words. I am sure that will help you a bit to understand the meaning, but it is not 100 percent of your understanding. So you have to read translations, but you can also study the actual meaning by learning the pattern of the scripture and by searching the dictionary of that language, which will help you conclude whether what you are reading is right or wrong or whether it's properly translated.

We should understand first the language in which it's written. Now, I am not talking about mere language—there are different ways of representing sentences and expressing views. There are different ways to explain patterns, like

- 1) LITERAL SENTENCES
- 2) ALLEGORICAL SENTENCES
- 3) SYMBOLIC SENTENCES
- 4) NUMERICAL SENTENCES

Suppose someone says, "I SAW A SHIP OF THE DESERT IN THE SAHARA.

Now this statement can be understood in different ways by different people, as per their own understanding and interpretation. It is English but it still makes for different interpretations. Some might interpret it in a literal way, as in they saw some sort of vehicle which helps take them from one place to another in desert sand.

Some know how to read between the lines and the proverbs and riddles or derivation language; they know the perfect word for camel, which is also called a ship of the desert, and may interpret it the right way, that they saw a camel in the desert. Here that makes a huge difference in understanding the language; the statement which makes readers follow wrong things or right things.

I would suggest the translators crack the code behind the language rather than merely translating it word for word, and this should be explained in the beginning of the book—that some verses are literal and some of the verses are allegorical and so on.

**BIG QUESTION AGAIN.** Why do they do it? And why not?

The answer is in your mind; think and I am sure you will get your own answer.

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Hence that's how the mind plays an important role in the development of our body—and our belief and our search for truth, what to follow and what not to.

Beliefs keep on changing as we keep on progressing in our study and knowledge. Beliefs cannot be a constant form of our state of mind.

# Thinking Power

AS WE TALK about mind and body and thinking, so many questions arise. The power of thinking is the strongest asset of our human body. Thinking power lets you determine the difference between truth and non-truth, between right or wrong, between yes or no.

In order to know the truth and what we are into, we have to be thinkers rather than just blind followers. We have to take knowledge from our own minds and we have to take knowledge from our surroundings and from every source which will take us to the right path.

We are so lost in imaginary worlds and materialistic worlds in our society and in our own lives that we don't think over the miracle which we see every single day in our own selves and in our surroundings.

What car are we going to buy?

How does that work? And how will we know if whatever we are looking for is right and that we are not on the wrong path of life?

In search of the truth, some of us approach religious leaders, priests, or scholars and seek information about the real truth. We get some information from them and we take it for granted that their explanations are perfect and truthful, and we follow the same.

**BUT WHERE ARE YOU IN THAT?**

We don't know that the information is perfect and pure or right. That's the other person's perception, and if you follow

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that, it means you are following that person because he explained it to you, and you accepted it without doing your own study.

In terms of world study, we have teachers, and teachers teach us how to learn, but along with that we do our own study too; mere teaching from teachers is not enough. When we do our own study from the sources we have, we pass our examinations with good scores. We read and write until we graduate. But in religious terms, the teacher is the creator and his message is around us, inside us, in the scriptures, and maybe in our existence.

We have to find it on our own, and I am sure we will get our degree from the creator itself. Don't think that what scholars can do we can't do; we need to start from somewhere.

No matter how late it is, no matter how slow it is, no matter how imperfect it is, everything has its start.
